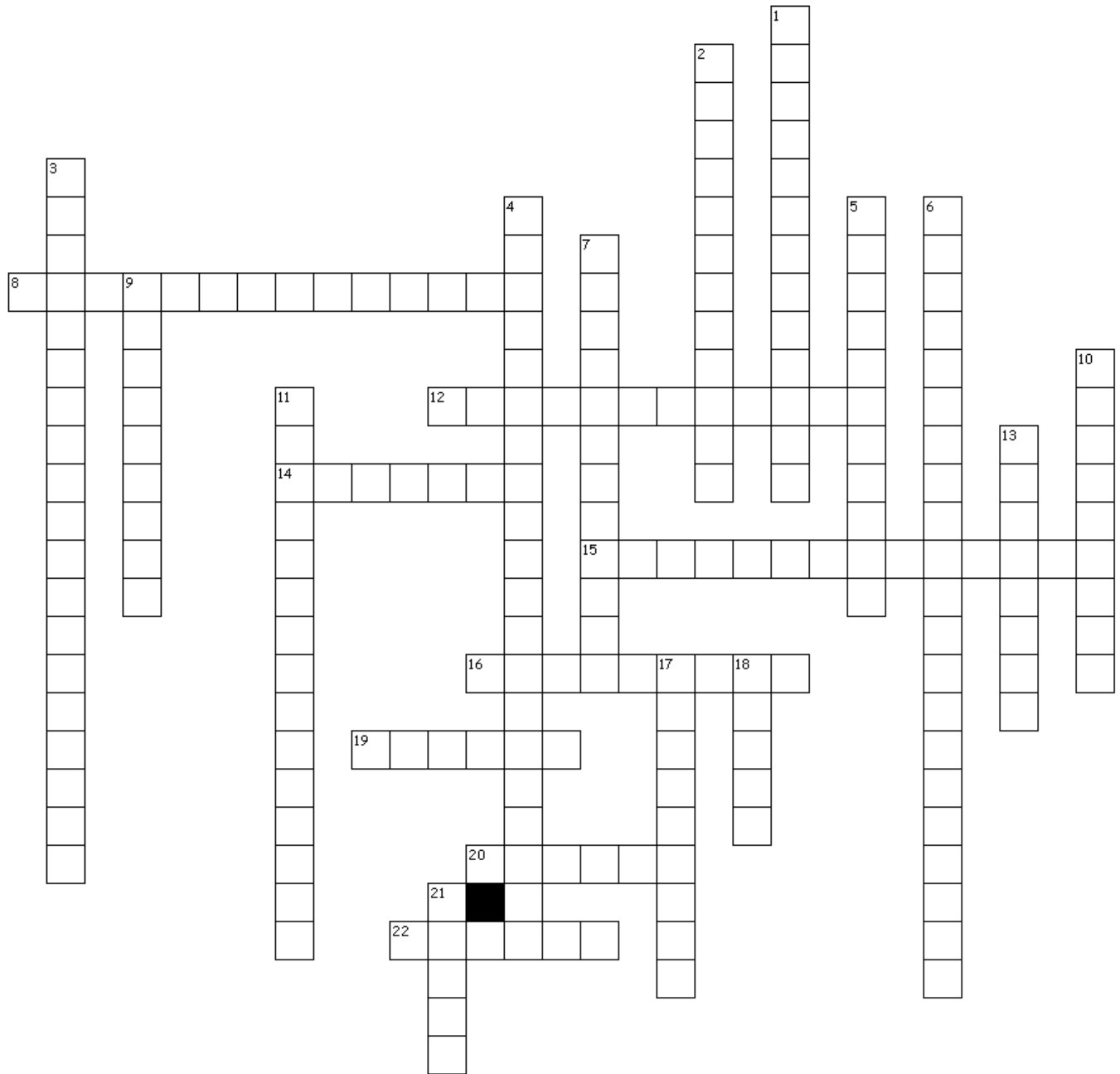


Puzzle 1
