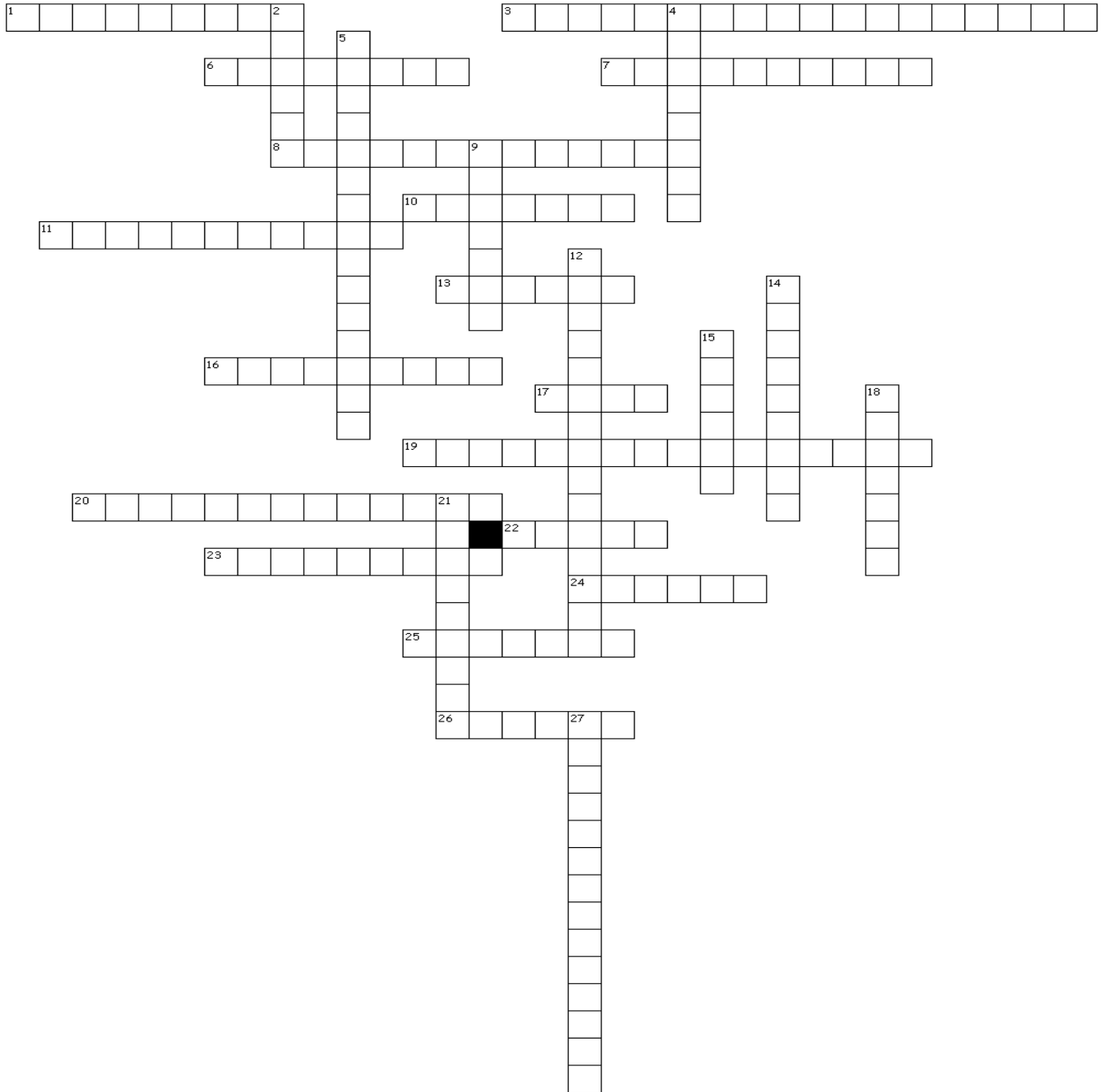


Puzzle 2
